1. **Call to order:** Sarah Bentley called meeting to order 7:02 pm

2. **Approve Minutes from Meeting on January 8, 2024**
 - a. A ***Motion** was made by Sarah Shaw Bentley to approve and adopt the minutes from meeting held on January 8, 2024. ***Seconded** by Sue Swan. No Discussion. ***Motion passed** .with 1 abstention (Chamberlin).

3. **Recreation Director Report**
 - a. Current/Recent programs:
 - i. 5-8 Basketball
 1. Program going well. Frog Rock is running the tournament this year for boys and the girls will be in Putnam this year.
 - ii. K-4 Basketball
 1. Program going well, the Ellis girls have helped in multiple sessions.
 - iii. Mind, Music, Movement
 1. Good attendance and good program run by NOW.
 - iv. Ski Club
 1. This has been a weather impacted program with multiple cancellations. The program has been allowed to tack on extra make up dates at end of session by the Ski Resort.
 - b. Upcoming Programs:
 - i. Winter Volleyball
 1. Approximately 25 registered to date for this program at Ellis Tech
 - ii. Spring programs
 1. Lego
 - a. This program will run on Wednesdays starting February 28th for 6 weeks
 2. Drama
 - a. Drama will be at the Town Hall again for the Elementary School again starting March 14th. The Middle School session will not take place due to the play at the Middle School this spring.
 3. Line Dancing
 - a. Line dancing will start February 25th at Senexet Grange
 4. NOW Programs
 - a. Creative Crawling will start on March 6th and run for 3 weeks due to early voting.

 1. The Town Wide Tag Sale is scheduled for June 22nd this year.

 - a. Grace Gourmet has been booked for all 3 concerts.
- viii. Beach Party
 1. Members of Triple Double will be at the beach party again this year on June 29th
 2. Details are being finalized for this summer kickoff event
- ix. Summer Programs
 1. Tennis
 - a. Sianna Goodall is on board to run this program but no dates have been set yet
 2. Basketball
 - a. Dates are set but the program times may be altered from last year
 3. Volleyball
 - a. Erin is still working on this program as she would like to include high schoolers if possible.
 4. Pony Camp
 - a. Still need to reach out to the host farm to finalize details for Summer 2024
 5. Golf
 - a. Still need to reach out to finalize details for Summer 2024
- c. Discussion: New or Old Business, budget
 - i. There is a possibility of not having Roseland Park available to host the Winter Festival next year due to paving project at the park.
 1. Marie suggested the Mansion, as they are a sponsor and the venue would be great for that event.
 - ii. Beach Bathroom: This project is still in planning phases with Elis Tech.
 1. Bathrooms (renovation, ongoing maintenance)
 - a. Still need to finalize materials costs
 2. Beach/Bathroom Passes (security)
 - a. Erin would like to sell passes that support maintenance that would include a code to access bathrooms. It would be ideal to sell these at the start of summer beach party.

 - iii. Tennis Courts:
 1. Erin has approached the town officials to inquire if a Go Fund Me can be used to support the project. It was suggested to approach the BOF for CNR funds.
 - a. The commission discussed the benefits of using Go Fund Me including allowing for support by choice for this project.
 - iv. There are 3 new Recreation sponsors including Bell Rock Insurance, Sturbridge Orthodontics and Putnam Area Foundation. Current donations collected from sponsors total \$11,250 for this year.
