- a. State of CT Ag Report Joe Courtney signed on as a sponsor of the whole milk bill. And he put in another bill to nix non-dairy use of the word 'milk'.
- **b. Woodstock land map review** Map 5128. 125 parcels, Center Rd south of 197 around to Hager, 197 from Center up to Andrews, Town Farm Rd, etc. 25 sales in the last 3 yrs. Taylor Brooke headwaters. Elevated 650 to 850 ft. A few farm fields. The farm on Hager Rd is in probate and there's a farm equipment sale, land likely to go to the highest bidder.
- **c.** Other Woodstock Fair is having a goat show this year. But the horse show will likely be canceled. No chickens due to concerns about avian flu.
- **7. Announcements** IWWA approved several timber harvests. There is a new animal control business in town specializing in beaver control.
