- **a. CT Community Farms Preservation Program** This program has been revived, creating an opportunity for smaller farms to apply for preservation funding. Information is available through the Farmland Preservation Unit of the CT Dept of Agriculture's Bureau of Agricultural Development and Resource Conservation.
- **b.** State of Ct Ag Report Ag day is March 20th. Legislation is being drafted which would allow towns to increase the property tax exemption on farm equipment, from 100,000 to 250,000 or with no limit on how high a town could go. Also possibly using the model of the MA tax credit for dairy farms which would make CT farmers more competitive.
