Treasurer's Report: Friends Fund \$5,366.48 Regular Budget \$4,652

Additional money will be deposited from art sales.

Art Show: 10-12 people made appointments over the summer to visit the art show and two works were sold. Rachael will take it down on September 15 and does not need any additional help.

Last Green Valley; Philippa will pick up the supplies from the LGV headquarters and will lead the two scheduled walks on October 5 and October 22, from 10-11 and welcomes company!

Rachael will check in with Woodstock Orchards for a cooperative Fall Fling on October 10, 10-12 am. We will offer a Fall Scavenger Hunt (Philippa), a painting activity (Rachaelrocks or pumpkin/gourds) ((Philippa has the rocks, Jessie has the paints and brushes)) and a craft (??). Sara suggested something with corn husks?

Rachael thinks she will have WA students to run this and it may include face painting . We will need to buy the paints.

We will purchase some additional tools to remove the sod (Philippa) and Jessie will research the purchase of the Weeping Alasakan Cedar for the area opened by the fallen oak.

Philippa will warn the Lymans that we will be crossing some of their land to clear the diggings away from them .

Philippa has registered with a free woodchip dropping service to obtain free woodchips that will be delivered at some time beside the parking lot and we will need to drag them down to the swamp area where they can mature and become useful. In November we will rake!
