## **Meeting Minutes**

- 1. Call to Order
- Bradley called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.
- 2. Citizen's Participation
- Gordon Spink Sr. recalled that Eastford voters were promised that the park would be selfsustaining. He asked if tax dollars were being spent on the park. Discussion will take place at next month's meeting.
- Day Camp Director Liz Scranton confirmed that she has the Commission's mailbox key.
- She inquired about how to get Day Camp information to the public. Barlow will assist by posting Day Camp info on the Commission's website.
- 3. Approval of Minutes
- MOTION (Trowbridge / Lee ): To approve the 1-2-2019 minutes. Passed unanimously.
- 4. Financial Report
- Mullen reported that the account balance as of 2-6-19 was \$22,428.13.
- MOTION (Oleszewski / Baywood): To accept the Treasurer's report. Passed unanimously.
- The finance advisory subcommittee has not met.
- 5. Maintenance and Management
- Trout Pond Dam Updage: Trowbridge reported that he and Chairman Mayhew had met on Jan 8<sup>th</sup> with Eastford 1<sup>st</sup> Selectman Jacqueline Dubois to discuss the deteriorated condition of the spillway, options for addressing the issue, and the potential cost. Trowbridge and Bradley discussed the same issues on Feb 5<sup>th</sup> with Woodstock 1<sup>st</sup> Selectman Mike Alberts.
- The Woodstock BOS will discuss the Trout Pond Dam at its Feb 7 meeting. Bradley and Trowbridge will attend.
- The state has not yet responded to the Commission's 11-21-2018 request for dam grant info.
- In a 1-14-2019 letter, the State notified both Towns that an inspection of the dam is required by December 31, 2019.
- Oleszewski read a letter from Chris Mayhew announcing Mayhew's intent to leave the Commission in July. Commissioners expressed great satisfaction with Mayhew's leadership.
