The Commission will get state preservation guidance first, then go to the Town. An engineer will also need to study the trees and roots that are affecting the sidewalks. b. An effort will be made to help the two new members of the Commission to be more comfortable in their roles as Commission members. The Commission will have a discussion regarding the character defining features of the District, and also discuss the process of how public hearings take place. C. Signs for the Historic District. There is state money available this year for two signs, one at each end of Route 169, and then others in future years.
