MEETING MINUTES

C.Cutler (Board of Selectmen) stated that the \$1,110,000 in funding from the American Rescue Plan Act is earmarked for emergency response services in town. She added that the Board will be devoting a significant amount of time in the near future to the budget. Finally, COVID kits and masks were successfully distributed to residents recently. S.Blodgett (Planning & Zoning Commission) reported that the Commission is revising regulations related to affordable housing, along with continuing discussions on agriculture related issues.
