Definitions

National Historic Landmark (NHL): A property designated as an important national historic site by the National Park Service.

National Register of Historic Places (NRHP): A property listed nationally by the National Park Service.

National Register Historic District Outline (NRHD): A district nominated as historic by the State of Connecticut and adopted by the National Park Service.

Woodstock Hill Historic District Outline (WHHD): A district adopted by Town Ordinance, November 15, 1988.

Designated Local Historic Property (DLHP): A property adopted by Town Ordinance as a Woodstock Historic Property.

State Register of Historic Places (SRHP): A property listed by Connecticut's Historic Preservation Council.

Notes:

- Historic Landmark, National Register of Historic Places, Designated Local Historic Property and Woodstock Hill Historic District properties are automatically included on the State Register. The properties colored as State Register properties on the map are those that have no higher designations such as NRHP, NRHD, or NHL.
- State of archaeological interest have not been shown on this map due to their sensitive nature.
- Historic Property (HP): A lot parcel with a historic structure built between 1888 and 1940 as noted by field observation and corroborated by the Town or Woodstock Assessor's records.
