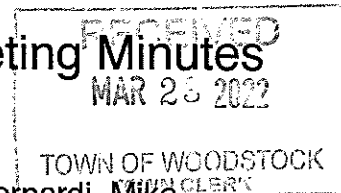


Quasset School Advisory Committee Meeting Minutes

March 16, 2022 at 4 p.m.

1. Myra called the meeting to order at 4:00pm and introduced the new members and read introductions of those who were unable to attend.
2. She stated that there was no correspondence and proceeded with the two jobs that Paul Pribble had quotes for at the Quasset school. Each would cost about \$5,000. First the two windows at the front of the building are starting to fall apart and Secondly the ceiling over the stove is settling and crack and needs repair. The town Hall wants more than 1 quote as someone may do it for less with a comparable amount of expertise. Paul's quote needs to be added to with a better explanation and we need at least one other quote. Mike Blanchflower is a builder and will look at it, but as he is on the committee he might decide not to bid on it.
3. A window was broken over the winter and it will cost about \$250 to replace. It needs to be replaced with old glass and that is often hard to find.

8. Our biggest focus should be getting quotes for the Woodstock Board of Finance.
9. Walktober - Should we be on their calendar next fall? The committee said yes and that they would help.
10. Open House - We feel that we would like to have a Quasset Open house when the School has theirs in the Fall. This way parents and children can see some of what we do and where it will be held.
