Director Pezzetti provided an update on the status of current programs, upcoming programs, past events, and possible future programs to members of the Woodstock Recreation Commission (WRC).

Current programs

Earth Month Town Wide Clean Up- ongoing throughout month of April, Sprucedale sponsoring with raffle at end of April for gift cards, 7 groups participating so far, trash disposed of either personal or transfer station

April Babysitter Training Course- 11 registered, Classes 4/12-4/13 @ WA Auditorium

Upcoming Programs

Squirt Soccer- starts May 1st at Senexet Village Road, 6 weeks, Boys WA team helping again, 9 currently registered

Spring Basketball Clinics (Boys/Girls)- 6 weeks instructional clinic at Church by WA, 6-7pm, Boys Mondays starting 3rd / Girls Tuesdays starting May 4th, open to all 5-8 graders

Spring Basketball Program (K-4th) – Saturdays for 6 weeks starting May 8th at WES outdoor court, split into grade levels for sessions, instructional program

Town Wide Tag Sale – June 5th or August date? Same guidelines as last year, add tables to side of Town Hall, when to sell maps?

Summer Concert Series – Little Big Band (July 16th with rain date of July 23rd) and Grass Routes (August 20th with rain date of 27th). Will book third band. Possibility of food trucks, but Roseland can't handle trash (could reach out to Mark or another service for the dates)
