2. **Approve Minutes from meeting on January 10, 2022**
 - a. ***Motion** made by Sarah Bentley to approve and adopt the minutes from meeting held on May 10, 2021.
***Seconded** by Marie Chamberlin. No Discussion. ***Motion passed unanimously** with Kathy LaBonte abstaining.
3. **Recreation Director Report**
 - a. **Current programs**
 - i. Senior Knitting Club – running weekly, weather permitting with 4-6 participants at sessions.
 - ii. Adult Co-Ed Volleyball- Mondays through the school year at WMS Gym, 27 registered, 8:30 during basketball season
 - iii. Adult Co-Ed Basketball - Tuesdays through school year at WMS Gym, averaging 10 each night, 8:30 during basketball season
 - iv. Youth Basketball 5th -8 th Grade – regular season finished, Killingly and Wentworth tournaments this week
 - v. K-4 Basketball – running until March 12
 1. Marie Chamberlin commented that she is very impressed with volunteers this year.
 - vi. Winter Volleyball – running until March 13th for 7-12th graders with Jeff Boshka, about 25 in program

 - 1. John Navarro would like it done on one day for Highway Department to pick up instead of month long.

 - 1. Recreation will provide candy for this event (and costume)
- iv. Babysitter/Parent Helper Training April 18th & 19th**
 - 1. Registration is currently half full
- v. Squirt Soccer starts April 30, 2022**
 - 1. 10 already registered for this program
- vi. After School Volleyball**
 - 1. On hold- Janet Abbott is waiting on gym availability
- vii. Memorial Day Road Race May 30, 2022**
 - 1. “on the road again” logo has been created and is in use for promotional purposes.
 - 2. Currently have 5 sponsors and notification went out today. All road approvals are complete.
 - 3. Sarah Bentley recommended cross promotion with Seana Weaver who has her upcoming marathon (April 30th) in Woodstock to benefit the Community Kitchen program.
 - 4. Kathy LaBonte recommended promoting with 5k/half marathon/marathon combo by creating a combo award incorporating Quiet Corner races.

- ix. Roseland Cottage Concert Series**
 - 1. Working with Roseland Cottage. Will have The Little Big Band back again and still working on cover band and Latin band bookings for this year.

 - 1. Registration is almost full for this event.

 - 1. Erin is working on summer programs.
