Recreation Director Report

Director Pezzetti provided an update on the status of current programs, upcoming programs, past events, and possible future programs to members of the Woodstock Recreation Commission (WRC).

Current programs

Adult Winter Yoga Session II, 6 participants, ends March 22nd. Hoping to bring the next class session in person and locate a space.

Senior Stretch class has 18 registered, only 3 are residents. Will devise an approach to balance the shared cost.

Upcoming Programs

There is some discussion of the possibility of adding another Senior Stretch session and partnering with Pomfret Rec as well. The next session may also include a potential charge (ex. \$10) for participants.

Past Programs

No new updates. Discussed at previous Rec meeting.

Possible Programs

The virtual cooking class did not have enough enrollment to run. We will revisit with a different date (day and time) and possibly an option for adults.

We are planning for a possible virtual art and drawing class. Details (instructor, timing for offering) to be determined.

Food distribution program may return to Woodstock Fairgrounds. A constable would be needed to help direct traffic flow, particularly at the intersection of 169 and 171, near CR Premier's location. No matter location, will be open to surrounding communities.

Will explore the possibility of a baby-sitter training online or limited capacity in person.
