## LEGAL NOTICE TOWN OF WOODSTOCK TAX COLLECTOR'S NOTICE

The first installment of Real Estate, Personal Property, Motor Vehicle taxes and Sewer Usage bills, listed on the October 1, 2022 Grand List become due and payable to the Town of Woodstock on **July 1, 2023**.

Payment must be postmarked or in the office no later than **August 1, 2023, to avoid delinquency and interest charges**. Interest will be charged on August 2, 2023, on all delinquent payments, at the rate of 1.5% per month, or a minimum charge of \$2.00 on each bill. Sewer Usage bills, also have a minimum interest charge of \$2.00 on each delinquent bill.

Motor vehicle taxes are also are due by **August 1, 2023**. If Motor vehicle bills are **not paid by August 2, 2023, they are considered delinquent** and will be reported as "delinquent" to the Motor Vehicle Department. Remember, you may not register your vehicle if your Town Motor Vehicle taxes are delinquent.

If you have any questions, please contact the Tax Collector's office: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (4:15 p.m. for payments.); Wednesday 8:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. (5:45 p.m. for payments.) **Fridays, the Woodstock Town Hall is CLOSED**.

PAYMENTS are encouraged and accepted online via e-check and debit/credit cards – WoodstockCT.Gov; Pay Taxes Online. Payments are also accepted, at our Tax Collector's window, or dropped off in our Silver Drop Box out front.

The office will be closed on Tuesday, July 4, 2023 in observance of Independence Day.
