Description of Timber Harvest:

Objective: Reduce invasive plants, increase structural and compositional diversity, maintain forest cover, enhance habitat diversity, and create an early successional habitat.

Treatment: Treat both woody and herbaceous invasive plants for 3 years, create a 5.4 ac early successional habitat, create 3 small patch cuts equaling 4 ac in size, install a temporary stream crossing for the duration of the timber harvest, grade and seed over logging trails to prevent erosion, install water bars as needed on logging trails, and use residual slash from the logging operation to create brush piles as wildlife habitat.

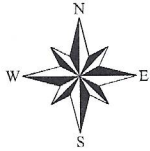

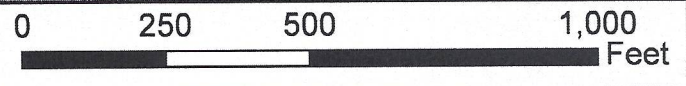
