Temporary wooded mats will be used on the wetland and stream crossings. Approaches to the crossings will be mulched immediately following end of use. The property has been managed by Hull Forest Products since 1980. Buffers will be maintained around vernal pools and the Still River. There is an existing culvert on the existing access road.

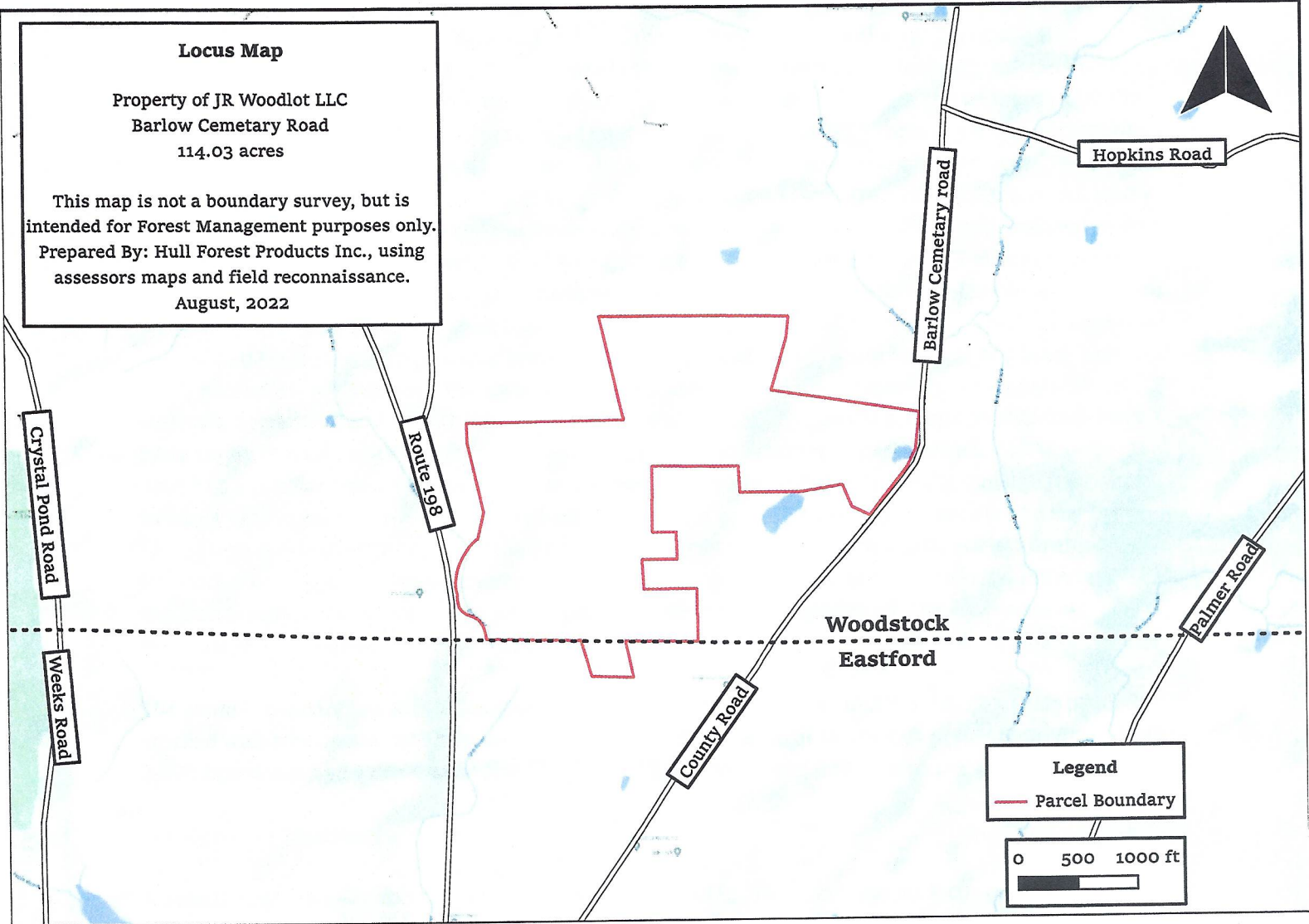

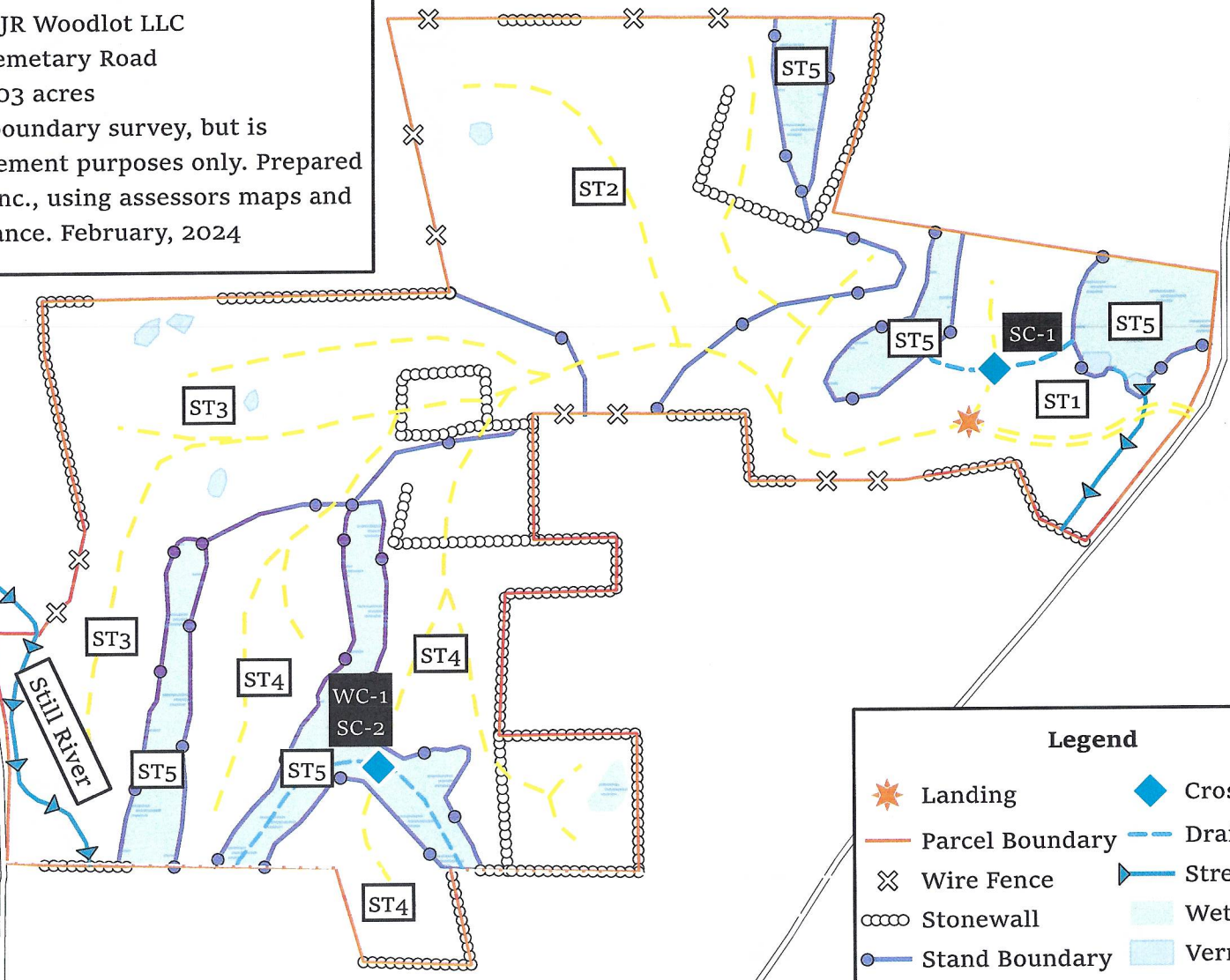

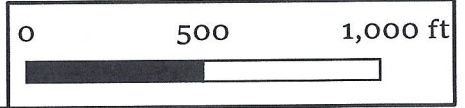
Still River

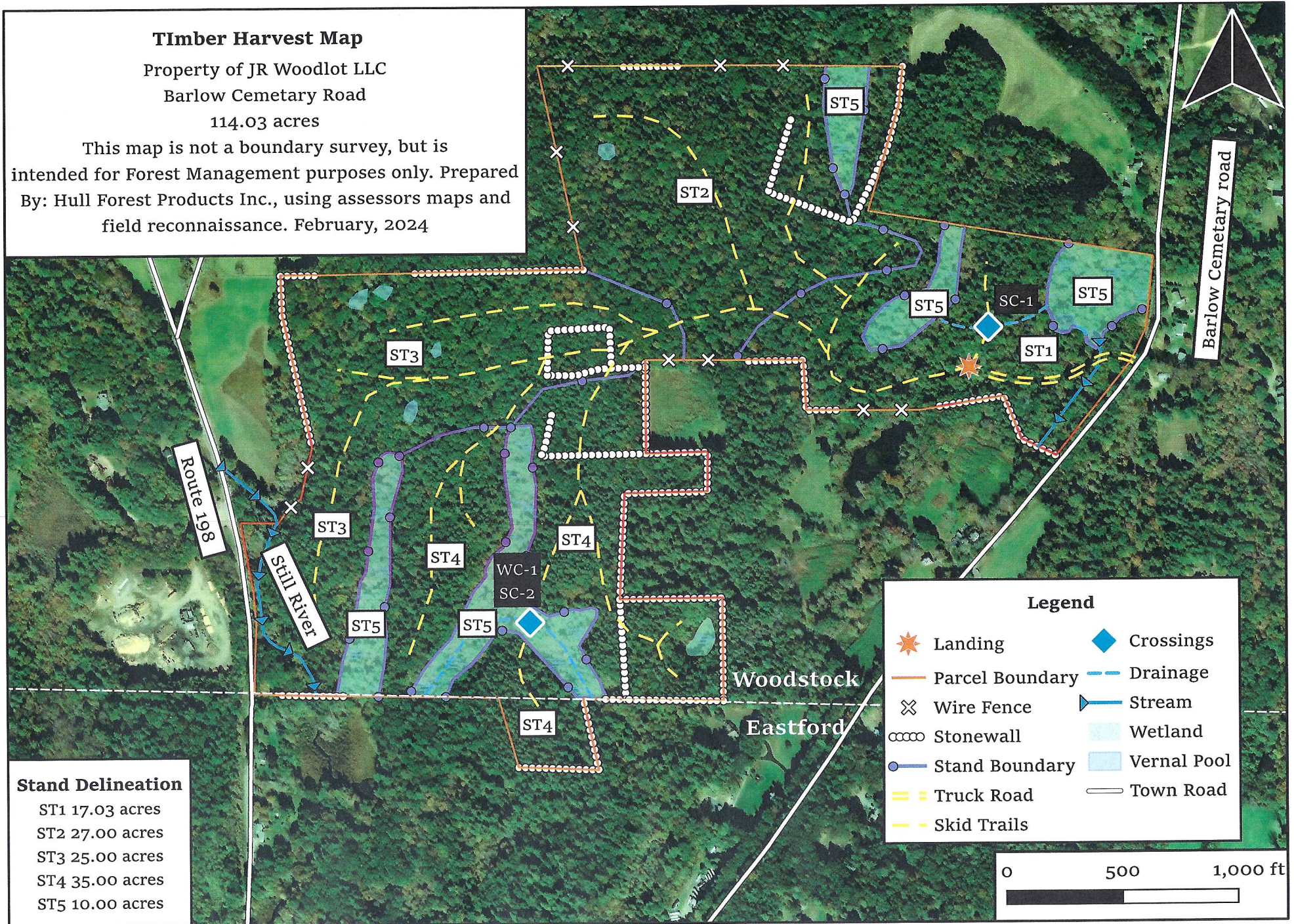
