We are attempting to create a young forest of diverse native species that will be more ecologically sound than the current conditions.

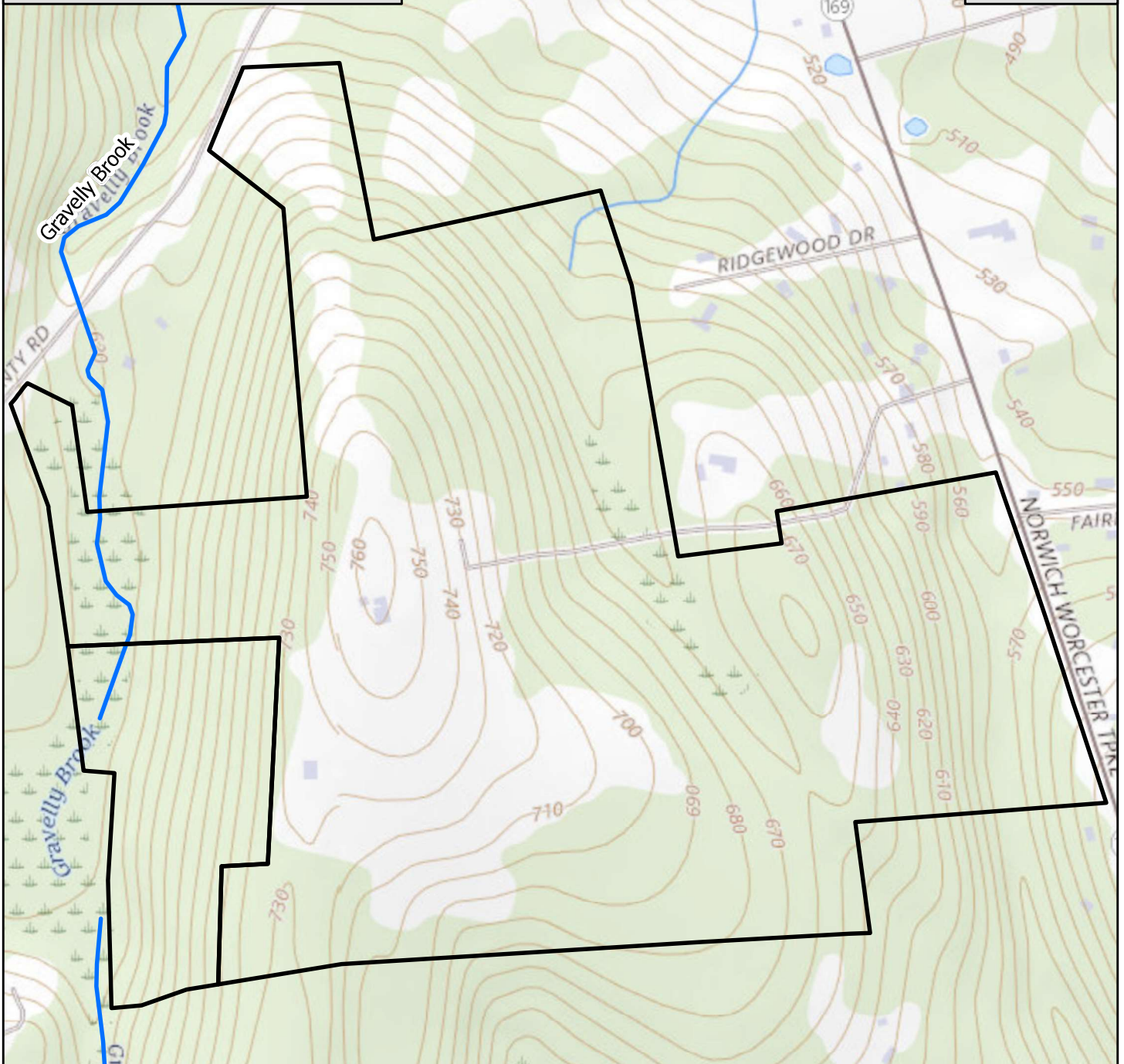

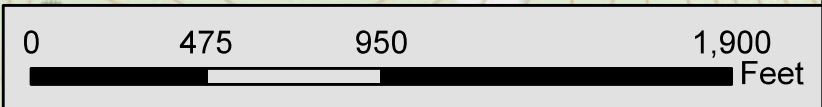

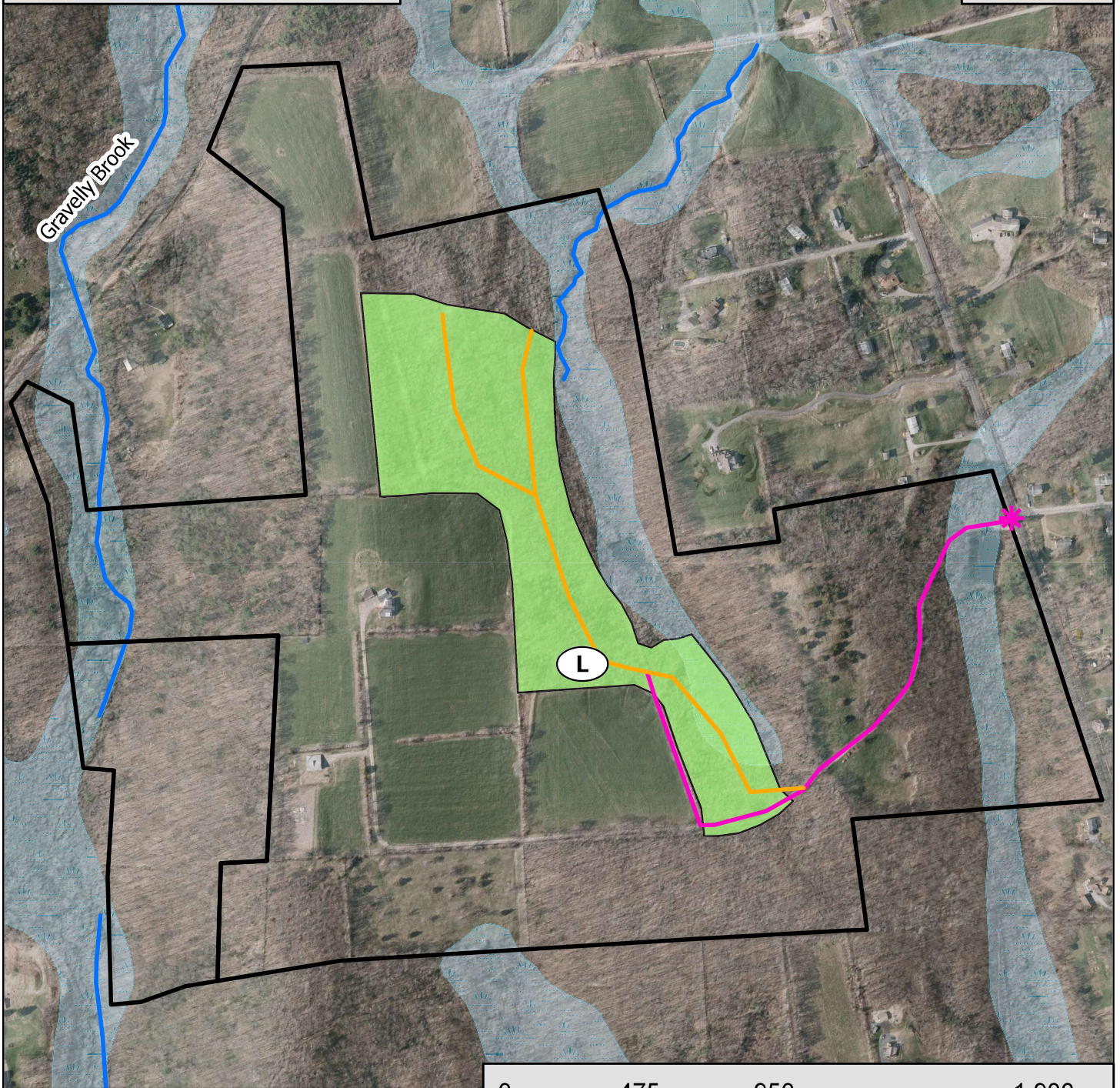









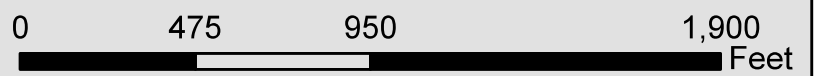
