No work has ever been done to the wall and it has kind of become a pile of stones that allot of those stones are now underwater on the edge of the property. My request is rather than rebuild the wall with cement, but to perform maintenance to add more stones/rock to bring the wall to the height of the land to protect the land from any further erosion. I prefer the natural aspect of doing that so to allow any lake life to live in between the stones.

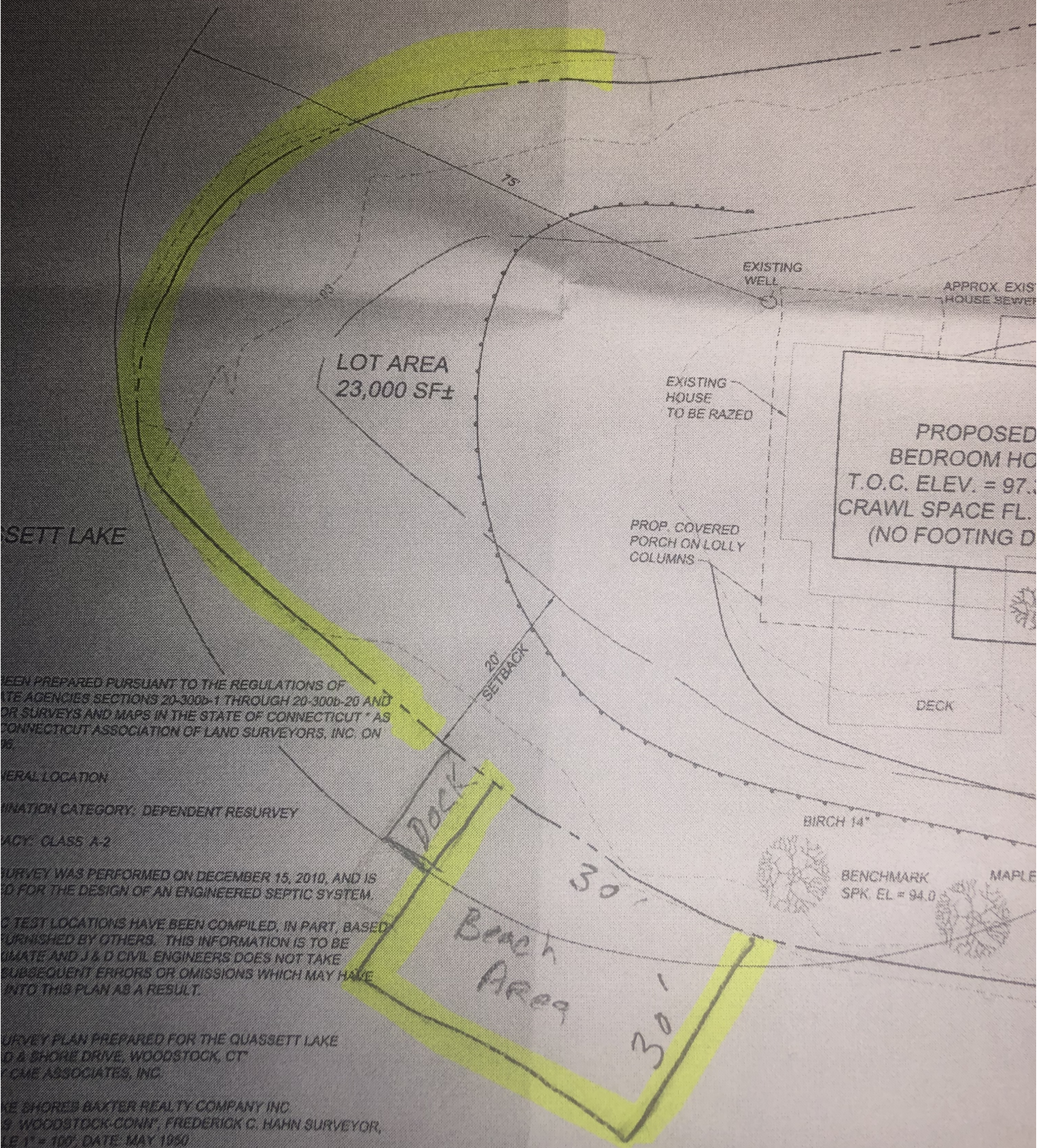
