I am having major flooding on my property due to a culvert drain on LakeView Drive which is part of the Lake Bunggee Tax District. Chris Baker is temporarily overseeing this drainage project but the engineer seems to be holding things up. The water is now like a river next to my home trying to make it's way to the lake. Our neighbors, Katie and Eric Rogala are also affected by this flooding and lose the use of their septic and water. This problem has been occurring when it rains for over a year and a half. I spoke with our temporary Roads Chair at Lake Bunggee and said there needs to be a temporary emergency fix until the full drain project can be completed in the spring.

Chris' suggestion would like to dig a trench and put stone down with hopes it will divert the water to the lake and then have the job upgraded with engineered plans in the spring of 2024. He would like support in writing from the town so they can move forward with this. Thank you.
