Additional Veterans' Exemption Application Information

The filing period for the Additional Veterans' Exemption application is February 1st through September 26th, 2024. The maximum income limit for unmarried applicants is \$43,800, for married applicants is \$53,400 with the following exceptions:

- Veteran Disability payments are not counted for AdVet applications
- For 100% VA determined Disabled Veterans, only adjusted gross income is counted, maximum income limit for unmarried applicant is \$18,000, married applicants is \$21,000.

The following proof of income is required:

- If you file income taxes, you will need to provide a signed copy of your 2023 Income Tax Return and your 2023 Social Security 1099 Benefit Statement.
- If you do not file income taxes, you will need to provide your 2023 Social Security 1099 Benefit Statement and statements of all other 2023 income.
