Scheduling will attempt to fill off-peak & off-season room availability

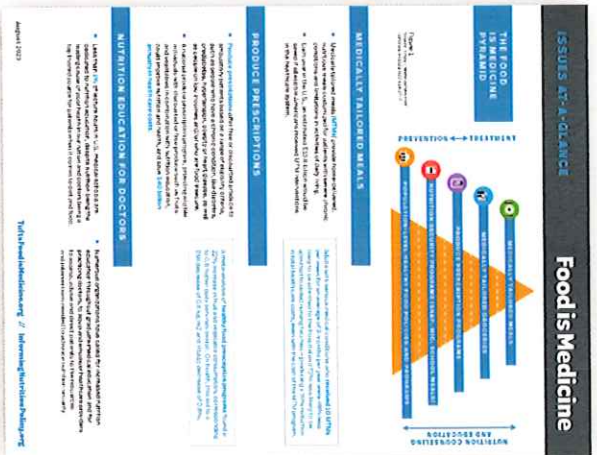
All music will cease by 11pm

All events featuring food & drinks will be provided by professionally managed caterers, licensed and insured with TIPS certified servers. Any required tents will be erected on a "per event" basis by a licensed contracting company after securing the proper Town of Woodstock permits & inspections.

We have updated our website to provide directions via Meehan Road, which minimizes the traffic on the dirt road (less than 0.2 Mile), and limits the impact to any neighbors' egress routes (driveways: 2)

A Woodstock Constable will be hired at the start of events for 2 hours to monitor traffic at Taylor's corner, until the State DOT posts "no left-hand turns" on Route 171. Senator Jeff Gordon & Representative Pat Boyd have been contacted to help accelerate CT DOT action on this important safety initiative....which is long overdue.

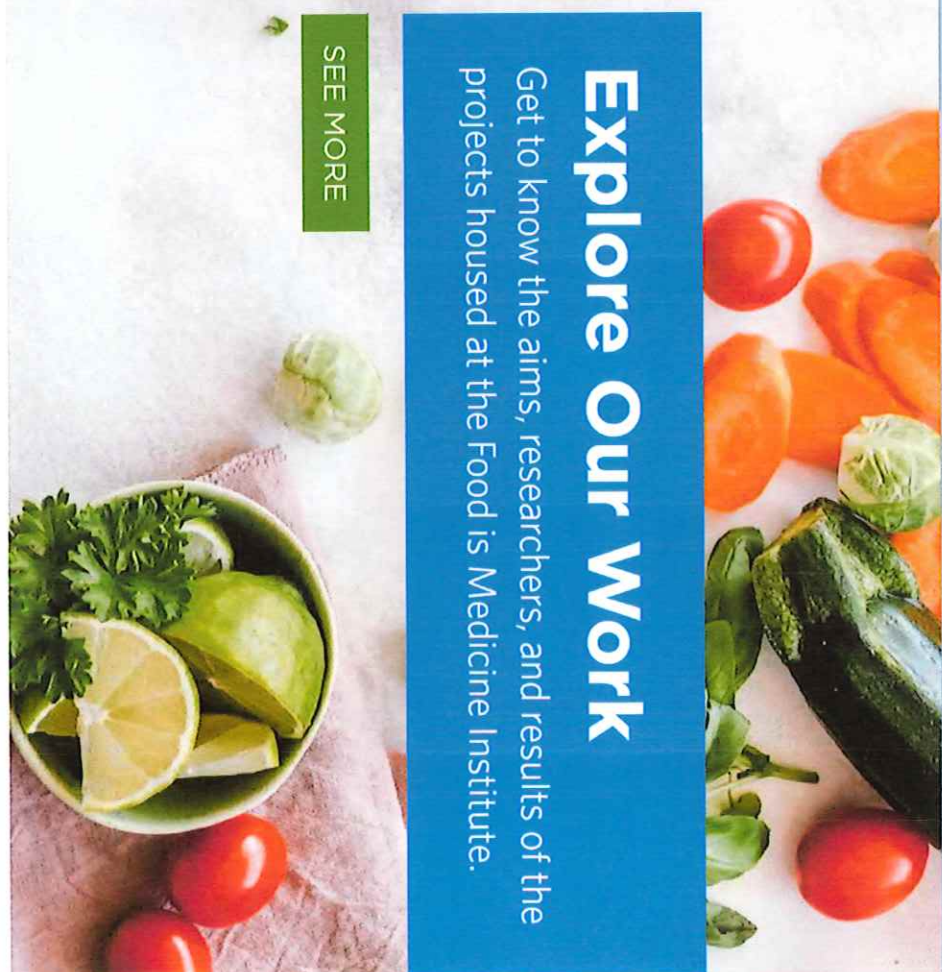

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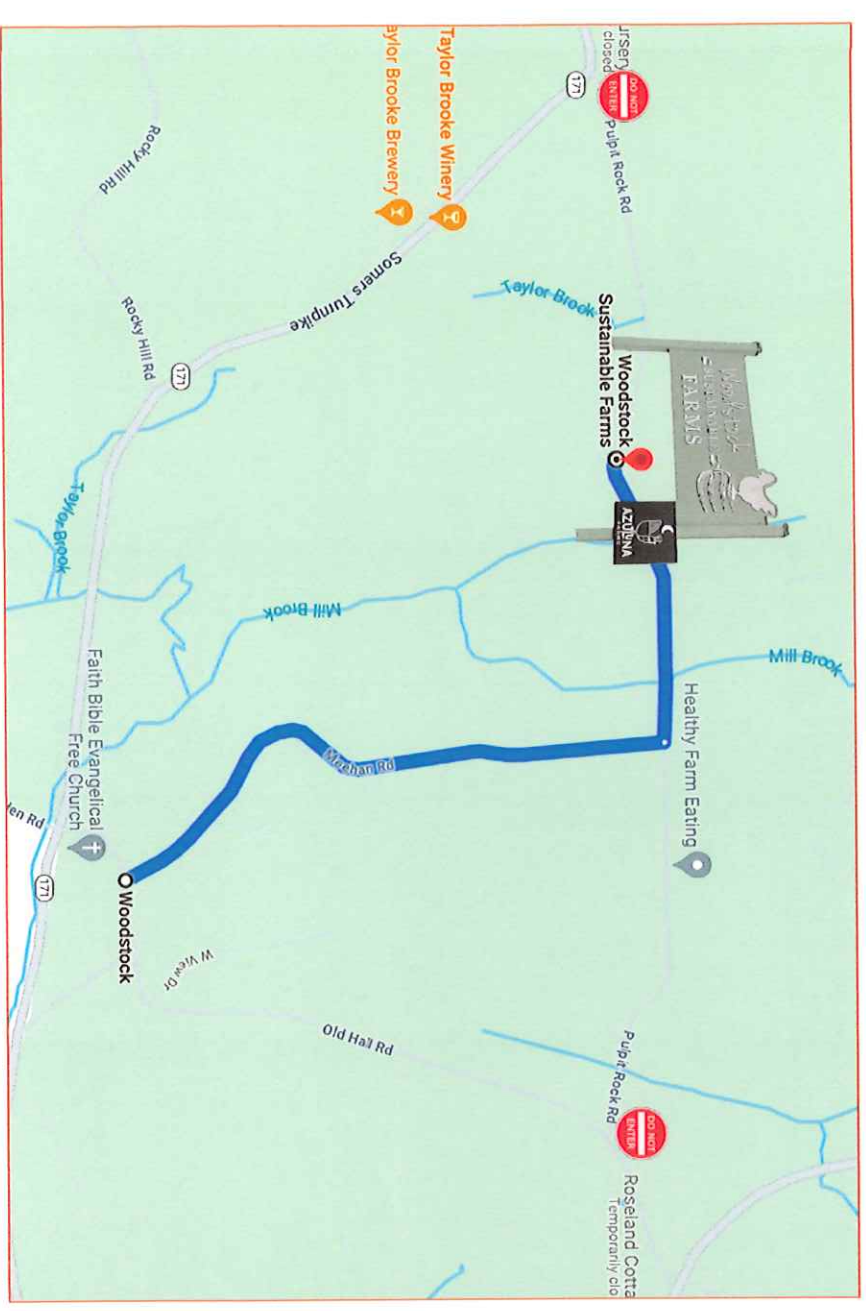
