1. CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order by Roger Gale at 7:15 P.M.

2. APPROVAL OF THE REGULAR MEETING MINUTES OF MARCH 26, 2019:

Morse **moved to amend** Item 3A. to read, "Morse stated that this property is not in the sewer district, so therefore, the sewer is not available for this property". Gale **seconded** the motion, **all in favor**. Rainville **moved to amend** Item 4B., remove "slight" grease build-up, **seconded** by Morse, **all in favor**.

Morse **motioned to approve** the minutes as amended, Rainville **seconded**, all in favor.

Stadig contacted Deep 6 and Parent Sanitation (left message). Glen from Parent Sanitation called Stadig on 3/30/19 at 8:37 am, he would contact Deep 6 when tank was pumped. Deep 6 repaired grinder pump which was bound up.
- **B.** Grease Trap for Woodstock Fair: Members engaged in discussion. Gale to contact NDDH for their perspective and Stadig to contact DEEP.
- C. Verify Rates for Sewer Use and Metered Billing for July Bills, per Tax Collector: Discussion followed using various percentage rates, with members concluding a necessary increase of 35% for metered customers and 25% for EDU customers for FY 2019-2020. Rainville **motioned** to amend the sewer rates as follows: 25% increase to EDU customers and 35% increase to Metered customers, Ellsworth **seconded**, all in favor.

Rainville **motioned** to hold a Public Hearing, tentatively, on Tuesday, May 14, 2019, at 7:00 pm, if the large meeting room is available. Morse **seconded**, **all in favor**. Stadig will check the availability with the Town Clerk.
